

### GEOINFORMATION MAP

**Crime mapping - Life Natura Themis (Observatories Crete)** 



Scientific research supports our point: Green crime is committed in our backyard. Nobody can actually picture it out, as offenders ususally come when nobody is around. Crime mapping helps in keeping a fluid situation steady, imprinting an invisible action, giving wildlife a voice. The geoinformation map assists:

- better planning of environmental patrols,
- qualitative and quantitative assessment of green crime,
- prediction of crime commission,
- interdepartmental cooperation in law enforcement,
- awareness awakening of local communities.

# Surveilance technologies - Agenzia Regionale per la protezione dell' Ambiente (Giuseppe Sgorbati)

The observation of surface changes or anomalies on earth provides significant data on human activity. Forestry, fires, landfills, water use, use of pesticides can be surveiled. It is just a matter of interpreting images and proceed to ground investigation.

Image comparison reveals torching for creating grazing lands and illegal logging. Color changes indicate possible plant diseases, vegetation threats, or extensive pesticide usage.

Remote sensing of high vegetation combined with low rainfall leads to illegal water abstraction.


Monitoring river route, wideness and lenght reveals illegal constructions on the riverbanks. Hidden waste disposal sites or landfills can be seing from above. Thermal emmissions show decomposition.

Surveilance prevent illegal storage of non waste endangering forest fires.

# SUBSIDIES FOR GRAZING TORCHING FOR GRAZELAND



Life Natura Themis (Observatories Crete)

Torching has been "traditionally" used by farmers as a tool of creating grazing land.

The "Agricultural Policy Aid Scheme" produces digital map files with the data of beneficiaries.

The data became accesible to Fire Service Officers.

Subsidies have been recalled in lands where torching was registered.

Within three years, the torching ratio fall by 70%.



### POACHING ALERT

Identify offenders at crime scene

Real-time anti poaching tags help prevent species extinction.

Permanent monitoring via satelite informs about the GPS positioning and alerts a police task force to further investigate and prosecute.

### **REGISTRATION**



### **AUTOMATIC INSERTION OF REPORT**

The database is monitored by the Ministry of Environment and the project's partner SYGAPEZ which then takes appropriate steps to initiate investigations.

### **NOTIFICATION**



### **DIRECT REPORT TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES**

SYGAPEZ may order the local administrative authorities for immediate preventive, repressive or rehabilitative action.


### **Environmental crime unit**

A small adjustment with a big effect: By decision of the Police Directorate of the Prefecture, the "Environmental Crime Prosecution Units" may be created. A call will initiate that existing personnel get seconded internally. Two officers in each regional unit will staff each unit with no extra charge for the Ministry's budget.

Inspired by the scheme of the Massachussets environmental police, each unit refers directly to two state prosecutors in the Region specialized in environmental criime prosecution.

Additional training will be provided by Life Themis Partners, special military forces and state prosecutors. The crimes prosecuted are already listed and statistically tracked by the Environmental Observatories of Life Themis. There is no administrative collission as the new Law on the protection of Natura Habitats (Law 4519/18) foresees the cooperation with the police in prosecuting wildlife crime.
